Banco de México, created on 1 September 1925, was the pinnacle of a long-awaited aspiration by Mexicans. Its creation ended a long period of monetary instability and anarchy, dating back to the beginning of the XIX century, and during which a system of diverse issuing banks operated.

The 'Guide to the Archival Holdings of Banco de México', published in June 2020 on its website, offers information about the extent, scope and content of the archival material that it holds. These records are currently under an archival description process that will allow more precise findings for the queries made by the interested public.

The Imperial Ottoman Bank is one of the most fascinating banking institutions of the modern era.
