1. VENUE OF THE EVENTS

The conference and the workshop will take place at the Hyatt Regency Sofia Hotel, Vasil Levski Hall (Vasil Levski Square, 1504 Sofia).

The hospitality desk in the lobby will give you a badge upon arrival.

Participants will not be admitted to the venue and social programme events without the badge. Any loss of a badge must be reported immediately at the hospitality desk.

The language of the events is English. No interpretations services will be offered.

3. VISA REQUIREMENTS AND COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

In case you decide to take a taxi to the Hyatt Regency Sofia Hotel please make sure that you use the services of the taxi operator *OK Supertrans*.


Should you wish to use public transportation from the airport to the hotel (and vice versa) please note that:

- *Sofia University Metro Station* is the nearest stop to Hyatt Regency Sofia. From the station, the hotel can be reached in 6 minutes walking (450 m);
- *Eagle's Bridge Bus Stop* is within a 9-minute walk (750 m) from the hotel.


5. SOCIAL EVENTS

6. MEANS OF PAYMENT

The currency of Bulgaria is the Bulgarian Lev (BGN). No payments in other currencies are accepted. Foreign currencies can be exchanged in commercial banks and exchange bureaus. All major credit cards are widely accepted.

The BGN is fixed to the Euro at the rate of 1.95583 BGN for 1 Euro. The exchange rate of the BGN against other foreign currencies can be found on the website of the Bulgarian National Bank: <u>http://www.bnb.bg</u>.

7. COUNTRY CODE

Country dialling code is +359; Sofia dialling code is (0)2.

8. EMERGENCY CALLS

112 is a common emergency telephone number that can be dialed free of charge in order to reach emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue, police).

9. POWER SUPPLY

 $220V \pm 10\%$ electrical supply. Supply frequency is 50Hz. Plug socket in use is the two-pinned Type F, also known as "Schuko".

10. WEATHER

Summer temperatures vary between 25°C and 35°C. Please check the weather forecast before arrival.
